Terms and Conditions

- 1) Once a completed booking form has been accepted in writing by Pathfinders, persons on the booking form (here after to be known as "participant(s)") will have entered into a contract on the basis of these terms and conditions.
- 2) The participant signing the booking form shall be deemed to sign for his/her self and acting for and on behalf of all other participants listed on the form and agrees to be responsible for ensuring that all other participants are aware of & abide by these terms and conditions.
- 3) Pathfinders bushcraft/survival/nature awareness courses/training/camps/events & demonstration(s) here after are to be known as Pathfinders course(s).
- 4) Pathfinder's states that woodlands & other habitats are potentially dangerous places & may cause harm, Pathfinders alerts participant(s) to these possible dangers. Whilst impossible to list all such hazards & dangers, Pathfinders has listed those, in their opinion that require the most specific care/attention: Risk of falling deadwood, trip hazards such as logs, roots, brambles, burrows etc. poisonous plants, eye level hazards such as twigs, branches, etc.
- 5) No unauthorised fires are allowed.
- 6) Axes, billhooks & the like are very sharp & are not to be touched or moved except with permission from Pathfinders. Parents, carers, guardians are required to ensure children within their charge are made fully aware of these regulations and the potential danger(s).
- 7) **Only** "fixed blade knives" may be used on all of Pathfinders courses.
- 8) Participant(s) agree they are fully aware that there may be risks involved during a Pathfinders course even under the safest conditions. Whilst Pathfinders will take every effort possible to minimise risk and ensure a safe environment the participant(s) hereby agree to accept full responsibility & assume all risk(s), including those caused by acts of God, of injury, death and or loss to his/her person and or property, knowingly and voluntarily.
- 9) The participant(s) agree to obey Pathfinders regulations that are put into effect to minimise risk.
- 10) Pathfinders reserve the right to remove participant(s) from its course(s) if participant(s) conduct is abusive or deemed inappropriate or they present a risk to Health and Safety.
- 11) The participant(s) agree that cancellation by the participant(s), for any reason, will incur the forfeit of a deposit in full. If cancellation is made less than four weeks prior to the course start date then 100% of course fee is forfeited.
- 12) Should Pathfinders cancel the participant(s) course for any reason; the participant(s) will be entitled to a full refund, should alternative dates not be suitable.
- 13) In the event that a participant(s) has a complaint, Pathfinders would appreciate that it is brought to their attention during Pathfinders course(s) in order that corrective action can be taken. However, should a problem not be resolved, a complaint should be made in writing within 28 days of the Pathfinders course(s) completion date. To the extent permitted by law, Pathfinders will not be liable in respect of claims first intimated later than 28 days from the close of the relevant course.
- 14) Pathfinders have public liability insurance and are covered to £5,000,000. It is advisable for the participant to have their own insurance cover.
